Water depollution project, Masay Lake, Antananarivo

The water depollution project at Masay Lake, Antananarivo, is completed with 350m² of floats, and hedges plantation along the banks and on sediments.

The project, in partnership with the capital mayor, the NGO EAST, the Région Ile-De-France and the APIPA from Water Ministry, want to treat two canal that come into the Lake Masay, the biggest one in the capital, that collect all the used water from the town and from runoff, by Vetiver System as proposed by La Plantation Bemasoandro. Even if the water quality is classified dangerous for human health, some hundreds kg of fish going to the market every day

and it is very urgent to act.

Some hedges are planted along the banks and also on sediments area.

In total, 46.000 Vetiver plants are put for this project: 21.000 plants on the 350m² of floats and 25.000 on banks, divided by two sites.

Slopes stabilization, TCE railway, PK277

Slopes stabilization under technical criteria of Vetiver System Technology (small drainage included)












In total, 20.000 Vetiver plants were be used.
